

# Kaleigh Pennington LIVE Memorial Scholarship

In recognition of the **1 in 5** students who possess characteristics of dyslexia, a scholarship will be awarded in memory of Kaleigh Pennington. Kaleigh was involved in an accident on October 21, 2018 in Lawrence County, TN. Her mother, Wendy, has served as a teacher in the Lauderdale County School System and is a graduate of Rogers High School. Kaleigh was known for her outgoing personality, friendship, willingness to help others, and love for family. In establishing the LIVE memorial scholarship, Kaleigh's family and friends wish to recognize the dedication to continued education and community service of a Lauderdale County School System graduating senior.

The LIVE scholarship is a one-time deposit of \$1000 to a two or four year college or university at which the recipient enrolls. Applicants must be planning to pursue a degree in a field that helps others or animals (i.e., education, criminal justice, health care, or a field dealing with animals).

## ELIGIBILITY

Applicants of the Kaleigh Pennington LIVE Memorial Scholarship must meet all of the following:

- Be a graduating senior at a Lauderdale County School System high school
- Have attended a Lauderdale County School System school for at least four consecutive years
- Have a GPA of at least 2.5
- Have an ACT score between 18 and 25
- Planning to pursue a degree at a two or four year college or university
- Provide documentation as having been identified as possessing the characteristics of dyslexia (if requested)

**All applicants must send or drop off their completed applications to the Lauderdale County Board of Education at the address at the bottom of this page.**

**Please do not submit applications to individual schools.**

## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Upon submission, the Kaleigh Pennington LIVE Memorial Scholarship also requires that the following documents be attached with the scholarship application:

- Attach a copy of the confirmation page of the FAFSA (EFC).
- Provide three letters of recommendation from teachers, coaches, employers, and/or church leaders.
- Attach a resume which includes your school, community, and/or church involvement during high school.
