COVID-19 Daily Home Screening for Students

Section 1: Symptoms

Please check your child for these symptoms each morning before sending them to school:

	Temperature 100.0 or higher/chills
	New onset cough or Shortness of breath/difficulty breathing
	Diarrhea, vomiting or stomach pain
	Sore throat
	New loss of taste or smell

Section 2: Close Contact/Potential Exposure:

	Has your child had close contact with a person with confirmed COVID-19 or suspected COVID-19? (Close Contact is less than 6 feet of an infected person for at least 15 minutes)
	Is anyone living in the house with your child positive for COVID-19?

If you answer **Yes** to any of the above **Symptoms and/or Close Contact/Potential Exposure questions please do not send your child to school.** It is recommended that you call your Healthcare Provider for further guidance.

If your child has any of the symptoms listed above while at school or they are found to be in Close Contact of someone with suspected or confirmed COVID-19 you will be required to pick them up. **Your child will need a clearance letter from your Healthcare Provider to return to school.**

If your child has any of the above **Symptoms listed in Section 1** and you choose not to see a Healthcare Provider, your child will need to remain home for 10 days from the date symptoms began.
