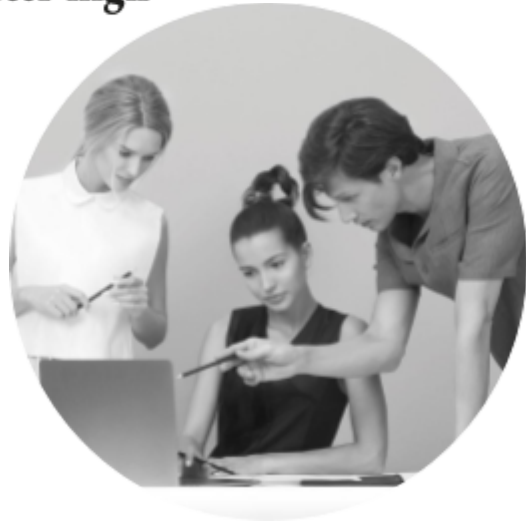


Do you have a child with special needs? Do you need information about their options after high school?
