CODE §§ 31-13-3 (3)]. The Board is to provide notice of the Contractors Alabama Immigration Compliance obligations to the Board. Grantees, or those the Board provides an incentive to, are to be provided a similar notice.

As an entity under the supervision of the State Board of Education, as condition for the award of any contract, grant, or incentive by the State of Alabama Department of Education to a business entity or employer that employs one or more employees in the State of Alabama, I hereby attest that in my capacity as CSFO (local board position) for the Board (name of local school board "the Board") that said Board does not knowingly employ, hire for employment, or continue to employ an unauthorized alien. The Board will be providing notice to its Contractors and its Grantees, or those it provides an incentive to, of their Alabama Immigration Compliance obligations to the Board.
I further attest that said Board is enrolled in the E-Verify program and attached to this Affidavit is our E-Verify Memorandum of Understanding confirming such program enrollment. I have read this Affidavit and swear and affirm that it is true and correct. Signature of Affiant
