

Kindergarten: What Will They Learn?
Reading and Math (This list is not all inclusive.)

READING/LANGUAGE ARTS

- ✚ Identify upper and lower case letters.
- ✚ Demonstrate letter sound association – initial consonant sounds, final consonant sounds, and medial short vowel sounds example: c a t
- ✚ Blend sounds to form words. C A T → CAT
- ✚ Read kindergarten high frequency words by sight.
- ✚ Make predictions, state main ideas, draw conclusions and monitor comprehension while listening.
- ✚ Recall the sequence of events in oral stories.
- ✚ Print upper and lower case letters legibly.
- ✚ Capitalize the first word in a sentence and use the period and question mark at the end of a sentence.
- ✚ Recognize the singular and plural forms of nouns.

MATH

- ✚ Count to 100 by ones and tens.
- ✚ Write numbers 0-20.
- ✚ Compare numerals between 1 and 10.
- ✚ Using counting strategies to identify greater than, less than, or equal to.
- ✚ Solve addition and subtraction facts within 10.
- ✚ Fluently add and subtract within 5.
- ✚ Work with numbers 11-19 to gain foundations for place value.
- ✚ Describe objects using length or weight.
- ✚ Identify, describe, compare, create, and compose shapes (squares, circles, triangles, rectangles, hexagons, cubes, and cones).
