MATH

- ♣ Add and subtract within 20.
- Work with equal groups of objects to gain foundations for multiplication.
- ♣ Understand place value of ones and tens and hundreds and properties of operations to add and subtract.
 - o Count within 1000; skip count by 5, 10s, and 100s.
 - Read and write numbers to 1000 using base ten numerals, number names, and expanded form.
 - o Fluently add and subtract within 100 using place value strategies.
 - o Add up to four two-digit numbers.
 - o Add and subtract within 1000 using concrete models and drawings.
 - o Compare two three-digit numbers using the symbols <, >, and =.
- Measure and estimate lengths in standard units.

- ♣ Tell and write time to the nearest five minutes using analog and digital clocks.
- ♣ Solve word problems involving dollar bills, quarters, dimes, nickels, and pennies.
- Represent and interpret data using line plots, picture graphs, and bar graphs.
