

## **Alternative School Rules and Regulations**

The following is a list of rules and expectations for the Lauderdale County Alternative School. This document serves as a general guide, and the student will be given other requirements and procedures as needed.

## **Procedure**

- 1. Students will arrive each day at 7:40 a.m. and depart at 2:10 p.m.
- Each student will sign in and receive scanning by the metal detector upon arrival.
  Pockets should be empty. No wired undergarments or anything that would set off the alarm.
- 3. Each student will have assignments from their home school and expectations to complete those within the allotted time (Schoology, Edgenuity, teacher-made, etc.).
- 4. Students will be responsible for cleaning and maintaining their personal space and common areas such as the restroom daily.
- 5. When school assignments are complete, students will work on something constructive such as the following: researching careers, colleges, jobs, and anything positive that would be of future interest. Absolutely no music or videos. Sleeping will not be allowed.
- 6. Students will make up all absences. No exceptions.
- 7. All assignments not completed on time will count as a zero.
- 8. Students must have all learning materials including Chromebook

## Behavior

- 1. According to the district's code of conduct, all regular school rules are strictly enforced while attending Alternative School.
- 2. Students may **not** participate in any Lauderdale County School System activities while assigned to the Alternative School.
- 3. Students assigned to the Alternative School are subject to the policies, procedures, and consequences of the Lauderdale County Parent/Student Handbook.
- 4. Students assigned to the Alternative School may be issued corporal punishment when necessary at the director's discretion.
- 5. The director will not tolerate DISRESPECT from the student. Behavior issues may be presented to the Lauderdale County Schools Board of Education for further disciplinary action, including expulsion.
